



SCHOOL UNIFORM

Each pupil is a representative of the school and must take pride in his or her appearance. Parents are requested to make sure that the correct items are acquired. School uniform will be worn at all times, when coming to school and returning home, at school functions and as spectators at school matches. Pupils may come to school in 'civvies' only when permission to do so has been given by the school. Emphasis should be on neatness and cleanliness of appearance.

1.1 Girls Hair:

- Hair must look natural, without re-growth or any exotic colours. Hair is to be tied back not beyond shoulder length or longer.
- The fringe must be clipped back if it gets in the eyes.
- Only black, navy-blue, gold or white colours may be used.
- No dripping gel may be used.
- Braiding may not be of exotic colour or in an exotic style.
- Braiding may only be tied up in pigtails or in a pony

Boys Hair:

- Boys' hair must be well groomed, must look natural, without re-growth or any exotic colours.
- No styling with gel is permitted.
- Exotic hairstyles or step cuts are not permitted.
- Hair is to be tapered and shaped and may not extend on to the ears or collar.
- Boys of colour are permitted to shave their heads. No 'funny styles' are permitted and hair must be combed.
- Boys may not have any braided hair.
- Boys are to be clean-shaven every day.
- Boys who are not clean shaven will be asked to go home immediately to shave or shave at school with shaving kit supplied by the school.
- Boys are not allowed to wear ear rings or have pierce nose, eyebrow, mouth etc



NB. PLEASE NOTE. Both boys and girls who dye their hair a different colour will be removed from school until the hair has been returned to the natural colour.

1. Jewellery:

No jewellery other than watches and medical identification may be worn. Girls may wear plain studs or sleepers (silver or gold only) in the ear lobe (one earring per ear).

No other body piercing is permitted, including tongue rings / bristles.

2. Make-up:

No make-up or nail polish may be worn. All pupils are to keep their fingernails neatly groomed.

3. Uniforms:

On arriving at school and leaving school the full uniform of the day must be worn anywhere in public.

Accessories

black or white gloves may be worn in on cold days.

Scarves may be worn during winter days only. Grades 1-11 may wear black or Navy-blue and matrices may wear white or golden scarves.

No decorated or oversize watches will be permitted.

4. General:

All learners' clothing, books and other possessions are to be clearly marked.

Lost property may be collected from the Receptionist.

5. Monitoring of Uniform

The learner's appearance will be monitored by both staff and the learners leadership team.

learners are expected to abide by the uniform stipulations and be prepared to face any consequences as a result of not wearing the correct uniform.

All learners are expected to arrive at school in the correct school uniform as from the first day of resumption. The uniform package includes

GIRLS

Blue V-neck tunic with school badge

White long sleeve shirt (no badge required when worn with tunic)

Grey slacks/pants

White Long sleeves shirt with badge when worn with pants alone



Socks – **blue with white strips for summer**

Socks – **blue with white strips for winter**

V-neck Long sleeve jersey –badge with school colours

V-neck pull over – badge with school colours

The blue with white strips tie.

BOYS

Grey long trouser

The blue with white strips tie.

White long sleeves shirt with badge

Socks – **blue with white strips for summer**

Socks – **blue with white strips for winter**

Blue V-neck, with two white strips on the neck and, sleeve carve, with badge

V-neck pull over with two white strips on the neck, with school badge

NB: Navy-blue blazer with school badge is for both boys and girls

All uniform can be purchased at school or prescribed shop or at school

Sports Uniform: The school golf T-shirt or as prescribed by the sport master / school.
